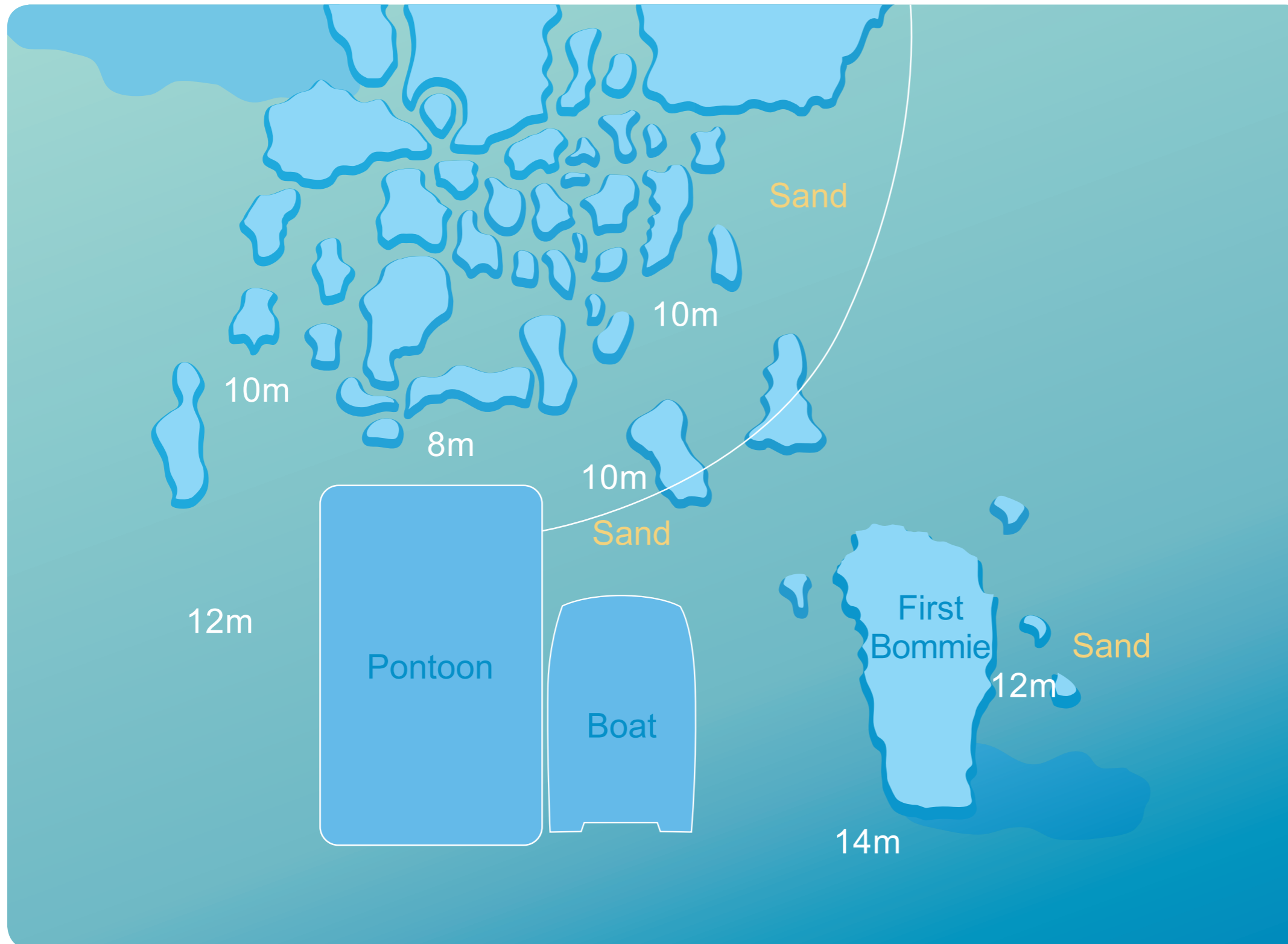




FIRST BOMMIE

Skill: Novice to
intermediate

Site: A large coral bommie to the left of the Norman Reef platform with several swim throughs – some of the best diving directly from a Great Barrier Reef platform. Home to large oceanic trout and a variety of nocturnal marine life waiting in the darker areas of the swim-throughs. The outer edge of the bommie is often home to large cuttlefish who hide amongst the gardens of branching coral.

Marine Life: Maori wrasse, trevally, emperor, anemone fish, barracuda, fusiliers, giant clams, spiny oysters, pipefish, snapper, oceanic trout, anemone fish and surgeon fish.
